



## **Shared Parental Leave Forms Explained**

These forms are intended for use for Shared Parental Leave (SPL) resulting from maternity. For SPL resulting from adoption leave please contact HR.

These are the forms needed by the mother / birth parent and the person they will share SPL with, known as the partner, to confirm eligibility and entitlement with their employers.

The forms can also be used to confirm eligibility and entitlement to Shared Parental Pay (ShPP).
